The bark has been soaked in water and is tested for pH with a meter for 1min. The one without dolomite is 5.5 - too low, the bark treated with dolomite is 6.5 - correct pH.

Place division into a new or sterilized pot big enough to allow 2 years growth. Washed bark with dolomite lime is pushed in around the sides. Slow release fertilizer added.
